ORDINANCE O-__-09

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC", SECTION 7-29, "MID-BLOCK CROSSWALKS", OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN TO RATIFY AND RE-AFFIRM THE INSTALLATION OF A MID-BLOCK CROSS WALK ACROSS OVERLOOK ROAD SOUTH OF OGDEN PLACE IN THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN, MORRIS COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Town of Morristown adopted Ordinance No.O-9-09 which established a mid-block cross walk on Overlook Road, 355 feet south of the southerly curb line of Ogden Place; and

WHEREAS, there were certain procedural irregularities as to the establishment of such mid-block cross-walk, requiring that Ordinance No.-O-9-09 be ratified, re-affirmed and re-adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Certification to the February 2, 2009 report dated February 4, 2009 recommending the installation of such mid-block cross-walk has been duly amended and re-issued as of May 14, 2009; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(a), the Town of Morristown has notified Morris Township, before the adoption of this Ordinance, that the Town intends to install a mid-block crosswalk as described hereinabove, due to the fact that Overlook Road connects directly to Morris Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Council of the Town of Morristown, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, being the governing body thereof, that Ordinance No. O-9-09, amending and supplementing Chapter VII, Traffic, Section 7-29, Mid-Block Crosswalk, of the Code of the Town of Morristown, to establish a mid-block cross walk on Overlook Road 355 feet south of the southerly curb line of Ogden Place be and is hereby ratified, re-affirmed and re-adopted; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all signs, posts, or other necessary materials, shall be installed to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that, in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(a), the Town of Morristown shall have notified Morris Township, through which Overlook Road corrects directly, that the Town of Morristown intends to establish such mid-block crosswalk.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
