



Setting up your account is easy. New users will click on “Create Your Account Now”, select a user name and password and enter their family’s information. Returning users will enter their user name and password to log in.

When registering, select the Winter 2017 season. Follow the on-screen instructions, select your program and make payment. Only Visa, Mastercard or Discover credit cards are accepted through the online system. Don’t forget to print or save your receipt!
