**The New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services offers a low cost spay/neuter program for qualifying participants. If you qualify, you can get your cat or dog spayed or neutered for only \$10.00.**

You qualify for the NJDHSS low cost spay/neuter program, if you receive any of the following:

- Food Stamps
- Medicaid
- General Public Assistance
- Rental Assistance
- Aid to Families with Dependent Children
- Lifeline Utility Credit
- Tenants Lifeline Assistance
- Supplemental Security Income
- Pharmaceutical Assistance to Aged & Disabled
