



**For residents who adopted a Dog or Cat or
are thinking about adopting a pet**

The New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services offers a low cost spay/neuter program for qualifying participants. If you qualify, you can get your cat or dog spayed or neutered for only \$20.00.



You qualify for the NJDHSS low cost spay/neuter program, if you:

- Are a New Jersey Resident
- Adopted your pet from an eligible licensed NJ shelter; municipal, county, or regional pound; NJ holding or impoundment facility that contracts with NJ municipalities; or a non-profit NJ animal adoption referral agency

AND

- licensed the dog in your municipality (licensing for cats is not required).

A pet spayed or neutered saves you \$5 annually on your pet license.
