## **Cauldwell Park Receives Major Improvements**

Morristown Mayor Tim Dougherty will be hosting a ribbon cutting ceremony at Cauldwell Park on June 1<sup>st</sup> at 11 a.m. to celebrate recent renovations to the park. Improvements include: resurfacing of the pool, reconstruction of the amphitheatre, rejuvenation of the basketball courts, and renovations to the fieldhouse.

“Summer is here and Cauldwell Park is the place to be,” said Mayor Dougherty. “We have renovated the pool, the amphitheatre, the basketball courts, and the fieldhouse. If you are looking for a place to cool off with your family and enjoy the outdoors, then come down to Cauldwell Park.”

Cauldwell Park is located at the corner of Clyde Potts Drive and Flagler Street in Morristown’s 2nd Ward. The pool is free for all users and will be open from 12 p.m. to 8 p.m. throughout the summer.

The Cauldwell Pool’s surface has been replaced with a Diamond Brite pool surface and a Cool Deck surface coating.

The Amphitheater’s rotten timber seating area has been replaced with new, ornate block seating and wall areas.

A new court surface and backboards were also added to the basketball court.

Exterior remodeling to the Cauldwell Fieldhouse also began in April and included a new roof, skylights, exterior doors, interior bathroom fixtures, and fresh paint.
