The MEC will be reviewing the DRAFT templates to select the language for the **SINGLE USE PLASTIC POLLUTION REDUCTION Ordinance**. The purpose of this ban is to reduce litter, protect the environment, and remove hard-to-recycle bags from our waste stream. The ordinance prohibits retailers from providing single-use plastic carry-out bags and non-recyclable paper bags to customers at the checkout counter of retail stores.
