#### **Criminal Damage Reported to Businesses.**

On Thursday, April 12th, Morristown Police were dispatched to two reports of criminal damage to businesses in the downtown area.

At approximately 10:48pm, police received a report of a broken window at Roots Steakhouse, located at 40 West Park Place. Police Officers were stationed a few hundred feet away at the time and immediately responded to conduct an investigation. On arrival, employees advised that they were inside the business when they heard a loud popping sound and noted a crack in the front window. The business was closed to customers at the time but employees had been inside cleaning at the time of this incident.

At approximately 10:57pm, an alarm activation was received for the T-Mobile Store, located at 95 Morris Street. Upon arrival, Officers determined that a front window of the business had been broken and noted that a small projectile appeared to have penetrated the glass and struck a display case. A second impact point was noted on the outside of the business. The business was closed at the time of this incident.

Morristown Police Detectives responded and both scenes were processed by the Crime Scene Unit of the Morris County Sheriff's Department. As a result of the investigation, it appears that both businesses were struck by a "BB" type projectile.

The investigation into this matter is ongoing but the Morristown Police are requesting assistance from anyone that has information or saw anything suspicious.
