Morristown Man Arrested for Criminal Damage.

On 06/05/2018 at approximately 5:45am, Morristown Police were dispatched to the Convent Mews Apartment Complex on Dorado Drive on a report of multiple vehicles that had been damaged overnight. Upon arrival, Officers determined that approximately 20 parked vehicles had sustained damage ranging from being “keyed” across the exterior paint to having tires punctured and flattened.

Morristown Police Officers and Detectives conducted a canvass to identify victims and to obtain information. During the course of that investigation, Detectives identified a possible suspect and conducted an interview which subsequently lead to an admission of guilt from 59 year-old Thomas Mina of Morristown. As a result of this investigation, Mr. Mina was charged with several counts of criminal damage, possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose, and unlawful possession of a weapon with additional charges expected as the investigation continues. Mr. Mina was served with criminal complaints on this date and released pending his court appearance.

Based upon this information obtained, there is no reason to believe anyone else was involved in this incident however, residents are asked to remain vigilant and report suspicious activity to police.
