

Morristown 2021 Jazz Festival is on!

After cancelling what would have been the festival's decennial year due to COVID-19, the Town of Morristown and Mayor Timothy Dougherty are proud and excited to announce that the Morristown Jazz & Blues Festival is on for 2021!

"I can't wait," said Mayor Dougherty. "The past twelve months were filled with so many cancellations and postponements that we all felt like the world was on pause. And I'm thrilled to announce that we can finally press play as the 2021 Jazz & Blues Festival comes back to Morristown."

The festival, which traditionally takes place in August, will take place this year on Saturday, September 18, 2021, from noon to 10 p.m. on the Morristown Green.

"We are pushing the festival back a few weeks this year in order to respect the state's reopening plan throughout summer," said Mayor Dougherty. "But, having waited almost two years now, we think a few weeks in the name of everyone's health and safety is entirely reasonable."

The event is free and open to the public. Parking will be available throughout the town and in the public lots near the Green. The festival is entering its eleventh year and will feature several notable jazz and blues artists.
