DIVISION OF HEALTH MORRISTOWN FREE RABIES CLINIC

Saturday, June 16th – 11am-1pm, Town Hall, 200 South Street. Dogs and cats who, to your knowledge, have never been vaccinated will be given a one-year vaccination. All others will receive a 3-year vaccination. All animals must be vaccinated prior to licensing according to ordinance 5-1.3 and 5-5.3. Dogs must be leashed, cats must be in carriers and accompanied by an adult 18 years or over. Rabies vaccination must be effective through April 2018 for licensing; otherwise a booster will be required. A free booster can also be obtained at this clinic. A micro-chipping clinic will also be available for a cost of \$25 per animal. Licensing will be available for your convenience. Please bring exact cash or check for licensing. \$10 for a spayed/neutered pet - \$20 for non-spayed/neutered pet. Note: Late fees will be implemented for failure to license by 6/30/2017.
