MORRISTOWN DIVISION OF HEALTH 2019 FREE RABIES CLINICS

\$25 Microchipping available for Dogs
and Cats. Saturday, June 15, 2019 and
Saturday, September 7, 2019, 11:00am-
1:00pm, Town Hall, 200 South Street,
Morristown, NJ. Dogs must be leashed,
cats must be in carriers and
accompanied by an adult, 18 years or
over. Dog and cats who, to your
knowledge, have never been vaccinated
will be given a one-year vaccination. All
others will receive a 3-year vaccination.
All animals must be vaccinated prior to
licensing according to ordinance 5-1.3 &
5-5.3. Rabies vaccination must be
effective through April 2020 for
licensing; otherwise a booster will be
required. A free booster can also be
obtained at this clinic. Licensing will be
available for your convenience. Please
bring exact cash or check for licensing.
\$10.00 for a spayed/neutered pet, \$20.00
for a non-spayed/neutered pet. Three-
year licensing is now available with a
three-year rabies vaccine!

MORRIS HABITAT FOR HUMANITY AGING IN PLACE PROGRAM

Morris Habitat for Humanity is offering Seniors of Morris County, NJ a special home repair program that makes accessibility and energy efficiency improvements to enable senior citizens to move around safely inside their homes and complete the routines of daily living. By doing this, the program hopes to help Morris County senior citizens continue to live in their own homes longer and maintain their independence. Examples of work include modifications and improvements such as grab bars, additional handrails or securing handrails on stairs, changing faucets and door knobs, installing hand-held shower heads, weatherization, accessibility improvements, and roof repairs. Costs to homeowner are only for purchased materials and other needed professional services such as electricians, plumbers, etc. Morris Habitat is registered with State of New Jersey as a home repair contractor. To qualify you must:

- Own and live in your home full-time
- Age 62 or older or someone else living in home age 62 or older.
- Live in Morris County, NJ.
- City and Property taxes current.
- Mortgage current or no mortgage.
- Meet income guidelines for program.
- Homeowners insurance in place and current.
