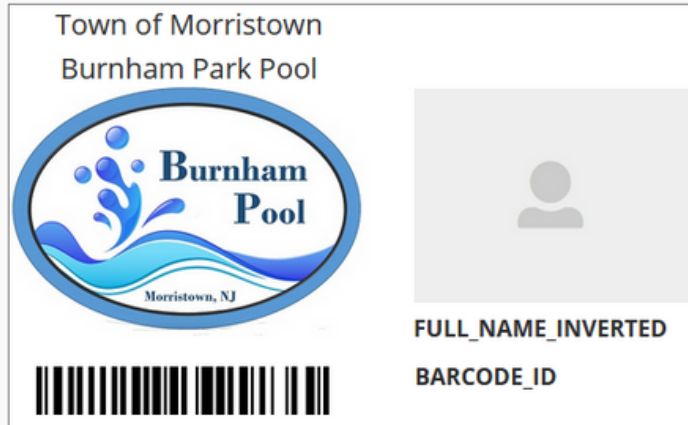

MEMBERSHIP IDENTIFICATION & GUEST POLICY

All members (except children under five years old) will be issued a Pool ID Card. Pool ID Cards are *mandatory* for entrance into the pool facility, there are no exceptions.



GUEST POLICY

1. Each *membership* (not individual member) is allowed **four (4) paid guests per day**.
2. Morristown Recreation reserves the right to limit guests when capacity of the facility has been met.
3. Members are required to remain with their guests at all times and are responsible for their guest's conduct.
4. Children may not bring in other children unless accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
5. Guest Passes are **digital** and loaded onto your Pool ID Card.
6. Guest passes are **valid only for the current season** and **do not carry over** to future seasons.
7. Morristown Recreation reserves the right to **suspend or alter the guest pass policy at any time**.



GENERAL RULES

- No person shall be allowed in the water when a lifeguard is not present.
- Abide by lifeguard instructions at all times.
- Outdoor swimming shall be prohibited during an electrical storm.
- No swimming will be permitted in the Dive Tank. Diving will only be permitted in the Dive Tank* (see dive test).
 - Only 1 bounce is permitted.
 - One person on the board at a time, including the ladder.
 - Jump forward only.
 - No swimming directly below, in between, and no swimming in front of the diving board(s).
- Swimming lanes are for lap swimming only.
- Appropriate clothing is required when at Burnham Park Pool. Proper swim attire is required in pool area including mesh-lined trunks for males and swimsuits for females. The Pool Manager shall have the final decision over proper attire.
- Dressing and undressing shall be done only in the restroom facilities.
- All persons shall shower before entering the bathing water.
- All children in diapers must wear diapers specially designed for immersion in water (such as Swimming Diapers).
- Do not wash out soiled diapers in bathing water. Changing will only take place in the bath house.
- Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Immediately report any "accidents" you observe in the bathing waters to a lifeguard.
- Changing of diapers on the pool deck is prohibited.
- Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs or symptoms of a gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven (7) days.
- Any person showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharges, or any other communicable disease shall be denied admission to the pool area.
- Any person with excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts or bandages shall be denied admission to the pool area.
- Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall be prohibited from entering the water.
- Conduct which endangers the safety and comfort of others shall be prohibited.
- When listening to music, headphones must be worn.
- The Town of Morristown is not responsible for loss, theft or damage of personal property of patrons.
- No alcoholic beverages, smoking, or gum chewing will be permitted in the facility.
- No food or beverages shall be permitted outside of the concession area.
- No glass containers may be brought to Burnham Pool.
- Animals are prohibited at Burnham Park Pool unless they are service animals accompanying persons with disabilities.
- Inflatable floatation devices are prohibited at all times, including swim floaties and water wings ('Swimmies').
- U.S Coast Guard-approved life jackets are permitted, provided that a responsible adult is in the water with the child at all times. Life jackets are not to be worn on diving boards.

***Dive Test**

An individual wanting to use the Dive Tank must pass a Water Competency/Swim Test which includes:

- Step or jump into water over your head.
- Float or tread water for one minute.
- Turn around in a full circle and find an exit.
- Swim 25 yards to the exit without stopping
- Exit the water without using steps or a ladder.
- The sides or bottom of the pool cannot be touched at any time during the test.
- The sides or bottom of the pool cannot be touched at any time during the test.
- Head must stay above water the entire time.

Water Competency/Swim Test can be administered by any lifeguard on duty.

ENFORCEMENT OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Rules and Regulations will be clearly posted at entrances to Burnham Park Pool.
- The Division of Recreation, its designated representative, or the Burnham Pool Manager, may close or limit the swimming facilities or establish additional rules and regulations whenever, in the opinion of the aforementioned, such action is deemed necessary or desirable for the protection of the health, safety or welfare of persons using the facility.
- Any person who violates Burnham Park Pool Rules and Regulations shall be subject to immediate ejection from the facility by a Pool Manager.
- Memberships are subject to suspension or revocation if a member repeatedly violates the Rules and Regulations, obtains a membership by means of a fraudulent statement, destroys Town property, trespasses during or after hours, or presents a safety risk to themselves or other members.
